



2021 SPRING SOCCER LEAGUE INFORMATION

Fall Soccer League places boys and girls ages 4-17 on teams, where they will learn to play soccer and compete together in a Christian environment with an emphasis on teaching them about the love of Christ.

Registration will be online at kids.ccphilly.org/registration this season.

There is no charge for spring soccer. We will not be ordering uniforms. Instead, each week your child will be asked to wear either a red or blue shirt. If you do not own a red or blue short or need shorts or soccer socks, they can be purchased for \$2 each.

Age groups are as follows: 4-5s, 6-8s, 9-11s (plus 12-year-old girls), and 12-17s. September 1st, 2020 is the date that is used to determine which age group a child plays in. A child who turns 4 by February 28th, 2021 is eligible. Siblings in the same age group will be put on the same team unless otherwise requested. We cannot guarantee any other requests will be honored.

Games are on every other Saturday from March 27th-May 22nd. Weeks in between may be used to make up rained-out weeks. Game slots will consist of a devotion time, practice time, and game. Devotions will take place before or after the game at the coach's discretion. Participation is not optional.

This league will be run according to state and local COVID-19 guidelines. As such, all participants must wear a mask or face covering, including during play. Currently, the guidelines do not allow for exceptions. Also, only one parent per family may attend each week. More specific guidelines will be issued in March.

All players must wear shin guards. Cleats are not required but are highly recommended. If this is a hardship, donated cleats and shin guards are available.
